Overcoming Barriers – Angela Yee

Read 1 Samuel 17

1. What key points from this week's message stood out to you?

2. Of these four barriers, which one do you most resonate with: frustration of being sidelined, lack of meaningful opportunities, pain of misunderstanding, or pressure of conformity?

3. Frustration of being sidelined (v. 15) — David was sidelined because he had a role to play which was not what he preferred. What do you observe about his story that helps develop a faithful mindset?

4. Lack of meaningful opportunities (v.17-19) — David acted responsibly despite his menial labor. In your perspective, how does the intersection of trusting God and taking action work together?

5. Pain of misunderstanding (v.28)— Share a time you felt misunderstood and what you learned from your cultural lens.

6. Pressure to conform (v. 38-39)— Where do you see this happening in where you live or work? What difference does it make to have an identity based on God?

7. What were some of the aspects of intercultural agility that you learned in how you can create a place of belonging for others?

8. What do you sense God is calling you to surrender or act on this year?
